Please note that girls wishing to play in the Ladies U10 Competition on Sundays do not need to be graded.

4. Grading for Other Age Groups

Under 11 (Saturday Comp) - Monday 15th February 2010 and Wednesday 17th February 2010 - 4:30 to 6:00pm.
Grading days for other age groups will be determined after the registration days, and players notified – also check our web site for details.

5. Insurance

All MVFC registration fees include the cost of insurance coverage for players – approx. \$ 10 for juniors and students, and \$ 60 for seniors. This insurance covers the player for all MVFC activities – grading sessions, training, trial games, competition games, and MWFA-endorsed challenge tournaments (such as the Cromer Cup and State Cup).

Student insurance does not include loss-of-income cover – senior players (U/18 age and above) who are currently students may pay the student insurance rate, but may not claim for any loss-of-earnings in the event of an injury.

All students under 18 years of age must indicate on the registration form the school or other educational institution they attend – this is a requirement of FFA.

Seniors registering as students must supply a copy of a 2010 year student ID card (or 2010 bus pass, etc).

6. De-Registration

– A player who plays less than four (4) games before 19th June 2010 may be de-registered if s/he will be unable to play in any further games due to injury or enforced absence.

Note that for de-registered players, MWFA charge the player the insurance component of the fees, plus \$ 30 administration fee. MVFC charge \$ 10 administration fee to process de-registrations. This means that for de-registered players, \$ 100 of the registration fee is non-refundable (\$ 50 for juniors and students).

7. Refunds of Fees

For any players notifying the Club of their intention to de-register before 1st March 2010, the refund applicable will be the full fee, minus \$ 10 administration fee.

See note 6 above regarding de-registration of players after 1st March 2010.

Players wishing to transfer to another MWFA club during the course of the season (prior to 19th June 2010) must notify MVFC of their intention, and obtain a deregistration form from the club, then register with the other club and pay that club's registration fees. Following that, the club will provide a full refund of the MVFC registration fee, less \$ 10 administration charge.

8. Player Transfers

A player may transfer to another MWFA club **once only** during the season. Refer to Note 7 above regarding the transfer process.
